Mr. Barnette discussed recent air quality enforcement actions and staffing updates.

Mr. Barnette informed the Advisory Board that curbside residential recycling collection services will be available to half of the residents in the unincorporated area of Forsyth County by the end of April 2018. He also stated that a compactor for comingled recyclables will be delivered to the Hanes Mill Road Landfill.

Mr. Barnette said that The Kernersville Recycling Center will reopen after a structural engineer has approved the completed repairs.

Mr. Barnette gave a presentation of the evidence of solid waste and open burning violations in Forsyth County.

Mr. Barnette concluded the Director's update.
