Meeting Minutes

April 23, 2026 – 3:00 p.m.

Meeting Called to Order

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2nd Floor Board Room on Thursday, April 23, 2026 at 2:59 p.m., Chairperson A.L. Collins presiding.

Chairperson A.L. Collins led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Chairperson A.L. Collins led a moment of silence.

Oath of Office Ceremony:

Forsyth County Board of Elections member, Joyce Krawiec, was sworn into office before Superior Court Judge, Aaron Berlin.

Public Comments

Chairperson A.L. Collins called for public comments, providing two minutes per speaker:

Motion to Approve Meeting Agenda

Chairperson Collins called for a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the April 23rd meeting agenda as presented; Member Krawiec seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Secretary Doomy presented the 2026 meeting minutes for March 2nd, 3rd, 6th, 12th, 13th, and 27th meetings. Chairperson Collins called for a motion to approve the minutes. Secretary Doomy moved to approve the minutes as presented; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Early Voting Plan Presentation for the November 3, 2026 General Election

Michelle Bobadilla, Deputy Director, presented early voting location options for the November 3, 2026 General Election. Paddison Memorial Library in Kernersville has remained the location with the highest vote turnout over the past several elections. Additional sites such as Walkertown Library and the Kernersville Recreation Center were discussed by the Board. Vice Chair Jourdan requested if additional sites in the eastern part of the county are added that signs be placed at the Paddison Memorial Library to inform voters of other back up locations for early voting. Voter turnout regarding the south side of the county and growth also discussed. Chairperson Collins called for a motion to table the early voting plan vote until additional information is reviewed. Secretary Doomy moved to table the discussion; Vice Chair Jourdan seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Approval of Polling Place Change for Precinct 709

Carma Buchanan, Polling Place Coordinator, presented the Board that Clemmons Middle School which is within the boundaries for precinct 709 is available on Election Day. In the past Mt. Carmel United Methodist Church had been used which was outside of the boundaries for this precinct. Secretary Doomy moved to approve the change of location for precinct 709; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

I Voted Sticker Contest Update

Jessica Loasching, Department Training Specialist, presented the twelve finalist’s drawings to the Board for the “I Voted” Sticker Contest. Voting has begun and is available on the Board of Elections website which will continue through May 11, 2026. The winner will be announced at the next meeting, and the winning design will be passed out during the November 2026 General Election.

Kerry Aguilera-Pineda, List Maintenance Coordinator, presented the voter ID outreach dates and locations to the Board which include Rural Hall Library on May 20th, 2026, Clemmons Branch Library on June 18, 2026, Walkertown Branch Library on July 21, 2026, Central Library on August 20, 2026, and Lewisville Library on September 4, 2026. Member Krawiec moved to approve the outreach locations and dates as presented; Secretary Doomy seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Kay Moore, Voter Registration Manager, presented to the Board the procedures for the same day voter registration process based on N.C. Senate Bill 747 and Numbered Memo 2023-05.
